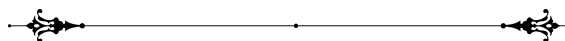

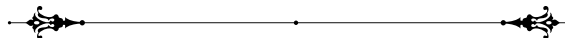

The **Alberta Baroque Ensemble** is a professional chamber orchestra whose repertoire is primarily the music of the 17th and 18th centuries and whose performance practices reflect the spirit and style of the period in which the music was composed. Formed in 1980 by its Founder and Artistic Director Paul Schieman, the Alberta Baroque Ensemble performs an annual concert series in Edmonton. Concerts include music by well-known composers such as Bach and Handel and not so well-known composers such as Leclair and Dittersdorf. The ensemble features many local artists as soloists in the Edmonton concert series and has commissioned three works by Edmonton composer Alan Gilliland.
